Clear Bag Policy

A clear bag policy is now in place for all Austin ISD athletic home events at Burger Stadium, House Park Athletics Facility, Nelson Field, Ellie Noack Sports Complex and Delco Center . That means no backpacks, duffel bags, purses, camera bags...etc. The options are clear bags no bigger than 12" X 6" X 12" or one-gallon clear resealable storage bags. The only exceptions are tiny clutches defined as no bigger than the size of a hand. This applies to students and adults.

Austin ISD Athletics CLEAR BAG POLICY

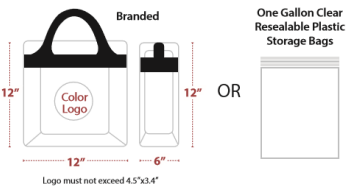
Beginning in August 2018, clear bag policy will be in place for all Austin ISD athletic home events. Approved and non-approved types of bags are shown below.



APPROVED BAGS

LARGE BAGS

To bring bags to a home athletic event, bags must be clear and not exceed 12 in. (by 6 in. by 12 in.) or be a clear one gallon resealable plastic freezer storage bag. One per person. Bags must be clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and have a maximum of one logo imprint not exceeding 4.5 in. tall x 3.4 in. wide.



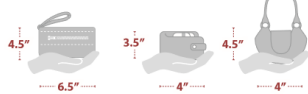
NON-PERMITTED BAGS

All non-clear and/or larger than those shown on the left.



SMALL BAGS

The only non-clear bags permitted are small clutch bags (with or without a strap) that are the size of a hand. Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at designated areas.



TEAMS APP



Parent & Student TEAMS Mobile App Grade and attendance reports for parents and students. Free download available from google play store and apple app store.

WHAT DOES THIS APPLICATION DO?

Parents and students are able to access their grades, attendance, and other critical educational information. Login can be saved for easy access, and parents can quickly switch between their students.

- Parents can view multiple children's attendance, report cards, and progress reports from one page
- Students can view their own attendance, report cards, and progress reports

School Cash Online

3. Review and purchase your child's back to school items using direct online payment
