House Bill 1481:

During the most recent legIslative session, Texas lawmakers passed, and Gov. Greg Abbott signed into law, House Bill 1481, which prohibits students from using parsonal devices on district premises during school hours.

EFFECTIVE THIS SCHOOL YEAR,

House Bill 1481 requires all Texas school districts to prohibit the use of 'personal wireless communication devices'—defined as any wineless electronic communication device, other than one issued by the school for instructional purposes, that is capable of transmitting or receiving data.

Items that must now be turned off and put away on Austin ISD campuses from bell to bell:

- · Personal cell phones
- Tablets
- Gaming devices
- Smart watches
 Bluetooth headphones or earbuds
- · Fitness trackers that can send or receive messages
- · Personal (non-district-issued) computers (laptops
- and Chromebooks)

 Two-way radios
- Iwo-way radio
- Any other device capable of digital communication
