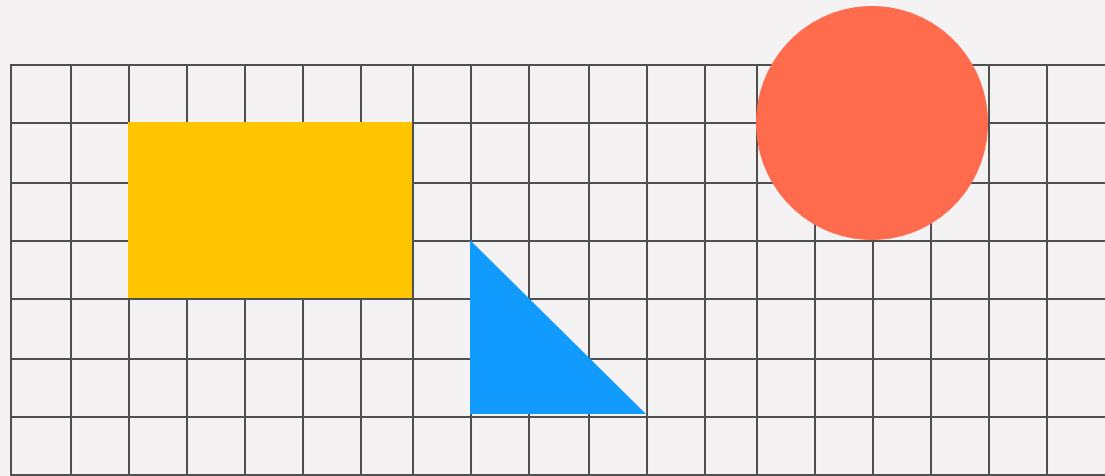


Creative Writing

Listen for air escaping Feel for air escaping and chest rising</p> 	<p>If no breathing, give two rescue breaths</p> 	<p>If still no signs of life Give 30 compressions on the centre of the chest and two rescue breaths. 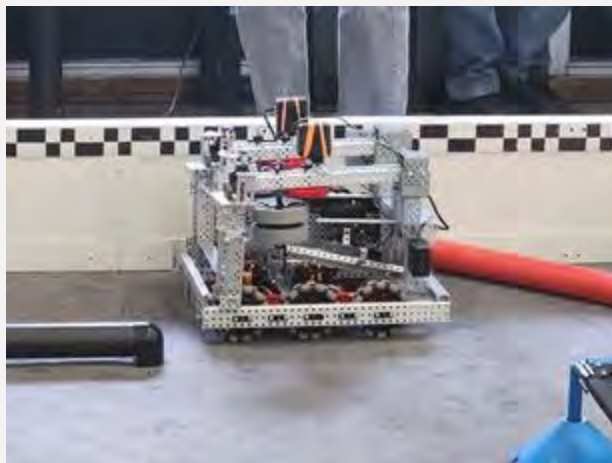
